

Dr. Peter Penson

Dr. Peter Penson is a Reader in Cardiovascular Pharmacology at Liverpool John Moores University, UK, where he leads the Clinical Pharmacy and Therapeutics Research Group. He is an Honorary Research Associate at the University of Liverpool, UK, and an active member of the Liverpool Centre for Cardiovascular Science. In addition, Dr. Penson is an Executive Editor of the British Journal of Clinical Pharmacology, Associate Editor of BMC Pharmacology and Toxicology, and a Section Editor of Archives of Medical Science: Civilisation Diseases. A Fellow of the Higher Education Academy, he has researched at Cardiff University and the University of Surrey, both in the UK and at the University of Regensburg, Germany.

Dr. Penson's research interests include cardiovascular pharmacology and clinical outcomes in cardiovascular disease, with a particular focus on hypertension, dyslipidaemias, and ischemia-reperfusion injury. He is primarily involved in observational studies, clinical trials, and meta-analyses. He is a member of the International Lipid Expert Panel, and he works with many international experts in the Lipid and Blood Pressure Meta-Analysis Collaboration Group. A pharmacist, registered with the UK General Pharmaceutical Council, Dr. Penson is a fellow of The European Society of Cardiology, and a member of The European Atherosclerosis Society, The British Pharmacological Society, and The British Society for Cardiovascular Research.
