Dear Colleagues,

It is my pleasure to nominate Veronika Todorovova for for the EAS Young Investigator Award 2022.

Despite Dr. Todorovova has joined our group only recently and is at an early stage of her scientific career, she has become been pursuing her research activities within the area of genetics of lipoprotein metabolism very enthusiastically. She has explored the genotype-phenotype correlations in familial hypercholesterolemia. An analysis of a large cohort of these patients with a long follow-up period is the topic of her nomination publication.

Dr. Todorovova continues her work in the FH field collaborating with the National FD screening project in the Czech Republic (MedPed) within which she has identified several novel mutations associated with FH phenotype.

Most recently Dr. Todorovova has contributed to the development of population specific polygenic risk scores in hypercholesterolemia and hypertriglyceridemia. Her latest Research led to elucidation of the role of the polygenic hypertriglyceridemia risk score in the development of familial dysbetalipoproteinemia (publication in preparation).

I thank you in advance for considering the nomination of Dr Veronika Todorovova for the EAS Young Investigator Award 2012.
